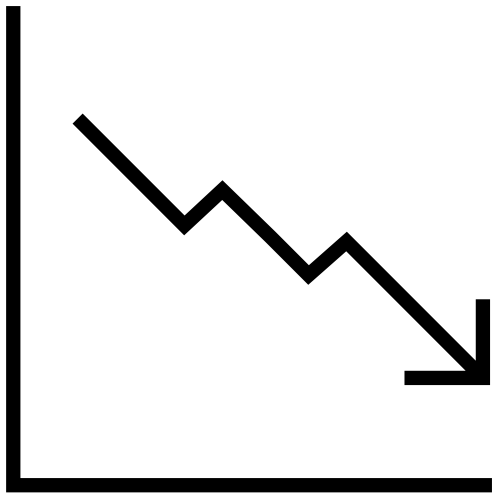

- **41% (482)** from Probation Services

2025 Admissions

- **774** Admissions:
- **38% (296)** from Pretrial Services
- **62% (478)** from Probation Services

CHANGES TO SERVICES AND ACCESS: 1115 SUD DEMONSTRATION WAIVER

Prior to June of 2022, all residential drug treatment services were state funded. With the implementation of the Waiver, all clinical services are now reimbursable for Medicaid eligible clients.

Must utilize ASAM 3 Placement Criteria (additional clinical services and staff)

Significantly increased cost – No longer buy the bed

Grant funding

Requires Full Court Agreement

Affects scheduling and utilization, 2012 11% ineligible for program / 2025 27.1% ineligible

CHANGES TO SERVICES AND ACCESS: I I I 5 SUD DEMONSTRATION WAIVER CONT'D

There have been some bed reductions including female 3.5 level of care.

There are currently **74** JB-CSSD clients awaiting placement at the APT Foundation.

- **39** are female
 - **14** are Pretrial Services referred Clients
 - **25** are Probation Services referred Clients

Only one program that accepts clients with primary mental health - Sierra Center (male only)

2025 HOUSING SURVEY DATA

- 9.5% (1,642) Pretrial Services clients were identified as homeless
- 3% of Probation Services clients were identified as homeless
- 1.6% of Family Services clients were identified as homeless
- In addition, 8.4% of Pretrial clients were classified as unstably housed.
